

Parking/Load out rules for LAMA members

- 1) Don't park in front of the fire hydrant. It's unsafe for nearby businesses and city buildings who may need access to the hydrant. It could garner a parking citation.
- 2) Loading or unloading from the Plaza may get you a parking citation. A member got a ticket recently for parking along the yellow curb on the Plaza side (not in an angled space) with flashers on. Her appeal failed.
- 3) Have your car out of the Calle by 7:30 am. Please drive slowly and cautiously on the Calle!
- 4) Turn off your car motor while loading or unloading.
- 5) Do not pull into the Calle for Load Out. This is unsafe for pedestrians and restaurant patrons and blocks the way for fellow craftspersons.
- 6) Always break your booth down before you move your car to a nearby parking space. People who have already broken their booth down need a space to park.
- 7) Carts: Cart your booth to the load-out zone before getting your car. Don't monopolize a cart while packing out.
- 8) Don't park on Granite St or any streets close to the market. Leave room for customers to park and come buy from us.
